YOUR GIFT CHANGES LIVES

\$50	provides a child with a month of live-saving swim lessons.
\$100	provides three months of monthly membership to the Mission Valley YMCA & Krause Family Skate and Bike Park.
\$250	provides two cancer survivors the opportunity to participate in LIVEStrong.
\$500	provides a child with a week of Day Camp.
\$1,000	supports a senior with a year of membership through our YMCA Active Adult (YAA) program.

Distributed \$1,163,967

in scholarships and subsidies to families, teens, seniors, and children who needed us most. 440 life-saving swim lessons were provided through scholarships last year.

299 youth engaged

in the Digital Studio, receiving STEM programming that allowed them to tap into their passions and develop skills.
