

"At one of the lowest and most difficult points in my life, the YMCA offered me refuge, support, and community I first interacted with the YMCA in my home state of Florida. Freshly extracted from a volatile and dangerous domestic violence filled situation. I was at a complete loss. I had three children, two of which were under the age of three.
